

UPDATED NEWS

While in the **Green Phase** Guidelines will be strictly followed at ALL Masses.
(Saturday 4:30PM & Sunday 8:00AM & 10:30AM).

We are limited to 50% of the church's seating capacity which is 100 people, however in order to maintain social distancing we can only accommodate 25% of our capacity which is 50 people in the church.

NEW Procedures beginning the Weekend of July 11/12:

The obligation to attend Mass on Sunday continues to be suspended. For now, we will continue to stream the 10:30am Mass on Facebook until further notice.

Those who wish to attend the weekend Masses NO LONGER MUST call Deacon Palmeri to sign up. We will fill the church pews in first, Social Distancing Guidelines will be in force: At least six-foot space between you and anyone you do not live with. Only every other pew will be used for seating. Any overflow of attendance will be expanded into the church hall. Chairs will be set-up and spaced appropriately. We will live-stream the Mass to a large screen television and after Mass we will have Eucharistic Ministers distribute Communion.

SATURDAY 4:30PM MASS only: Beginning July 11/12 the Saturday night Mass will be held outdoors as a Drive-in Mass on our Festival Grounds, (weather permitting). Social distancing guidelines will be in force. The Knights will be assisting with parking and directing cars.

Please remember that face masks are **REQUIRED** to be worn at all times while in the church. Hand sanitizer will be available. If you are sick, please do not attend Mass. If you have a chronic health condition or a serious health issue or are vulnerable to Covid infection, please do not attend Mass.

We will continue to post our Sunday Mass on our Facebook page for those who choose to remain at home at this time.
